

THE NEW JERSEY SKI & SNOWBOARD COUNCIL

Purpose: The Council was formed in November 1939 to promote amateur skiing, assist in the development of new clubs, sponsor and run inter-club competition, and generally to promote club activities in skiing. It is incorporated as a "corporation not-for-profit" in New Jersey.

Membership: The New Jersey Ski & Snowboard Council does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national, or ethnic origin in club membership or any sponsored activity. Club membership is available to any active, organized ski, snowboard, or any other snowsports club in the State of New Jersey and adjacent areas upon application and meeting certain requirements (By-Laws, membership list, and council meeting attendance). Contact any Council Officer for information.

Meetings: Each member club elects or appoints a representative to the Council, who has one vote at general meetings. Individual club members are also encouraged to attend Council meetings. Regular meetings of the Council are held the second Monday of each month, October through May, via Zoom.

On occasion, the Council may call an in-person meeting at a location to be determined by the Executive Board of the Council. When this arises, the Council will disseminate the date, time, location, and directions to the selected venue in advance of said meeting.

The secretary of the Council will provide the Zoom link to the club presidents, representatives, and alternate representatives of each club in advance of each meeting.

Due to special circumstances, meeting times and days may change. Always check your email, the New Jersey Ski & Snowboard Council website (www.njssc.com), or Facebook page (www.facebook.com/njskicouncil/) for more information and last minute changes.

SKIER'S RESPONSIBILITY CODE

There are elements of risk in skiing and snowboarding that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce.

- **1.** Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- **2.** People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
- **3.** Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
- **4.** Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
- 5. You must prevent runaway equipment.
- 6. Read and obey all signs, warnings, and hazard markings.
- 7. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- **8.** You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.

THE 2022 NJ SKI & SNOWBOARD COUNCIL STANLEY SHARAGA MEMORIAL PRESIDENT'S RACE

The 2022 NJSSC Stanley Sharaga Memorial President's Race was held on March 19, 2022, at Hunter Mt. Ski Bowl and was again a great success, with four clubs represented. The race had a total of 37 racers. This was the first SSMPR held since the COVID 19 pandemic. The race was held on the new race trail, Lower Broadway. The Hunter Racing Foundation and Hunter Mt. grooming team once again provided a great course. This year the scoring was done differently than in past years. NASTAR returned again to Hunter Mt. and therefore, the race results were based on age-adjusted NASTAR points (rather than a straight handicap). In other words a 20-something year old racer will receive less NASTAR Points than a 60-something year old racer with the same race time. The program is designed to level the playing field. Results for men and women were ranked from lowest to highest NASTAR Points and divided into three equal groups. Points were awarded within each group, starting at 30 on down. Team score was based on the top four men point scores and top three women point scores. In this way, clubs with the not so good racers had an equal shot at winning the race, and the more racers a club had the better chance to win.

Top team awards were: 1st - Trailsweepers, 2nd - Ramapo, and 3rd - Watchung. The individual scoring was again divided into thirds with awards for Class A, B, and C racers. The women's Class A winner was Karen Sanderson from Ramapo, with 2nd place going to Kari Hoyt from Trailsweepers, and 3rd place won by Carlene Bassell from Ramapo. Even though Kari had a faster run than Karen, Karen won because of the significant age difference. The men's Class A winner was Yuri Kobziar from Trailsweepers, followed by Jeff Viglielmo of Trailsweepers, with third place going to Dale Ziegenfelder from Trailsweepers. The Class B men's and women's winners were Bill Sidlovsky from Ramapo and Sandy Schwinzer from Trailsweepers, 2nd place going to Joe Runsdorf from Ski Bums and Elise Stoller from Ramapo, with 3rd place going to Jason Green from Ramapo and Katie Viglielmo from Trailsweepers. The Class C winners were Caroline and Marc Kornutik from Watchung. Second place went to Jackie Olivet of Trailsweepers and Greg Schneider of Ramapo with third place going to Denise Brecht of Watchung and Jeff Huth of Trailsweepers.


