THE NEW JERSEY SKI & SNOWBOARD COUNCIL

Purpose: The Council was formed in November 1939 to promote amateur skiing, assist in the development of new clubs, sponsor and run inter-club competition, and generally to promote club activity in skiing. It is incorporated as a "corporation not-for-profit" in New Jersey.

Membership: The New Jersey Ski & Snowboard Council does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national, or ethnic origin in club membership or any sponsored activity. Club membership is available to any active, organized ski club in the State of New Jersey and adjacent areas upon application and meeting certain requirements (By-Laws, membership list, and council meeting attendance). Contact any Council Officer for information.

Meetings: Each member club elects or appoints a representative to the Council, who has one vote at general meetings. Individual club members are also encouraged to attend Council meetings. Regular meetings of the Council are held the second Monday of each month, September through May, at the American Legion Hall, Clark, New Jersey, at 7:00 pm.

Directions: From Garden State Parkway (GSP) North, take exit 135, and bear right off exit to Brant Ave. From GSP South, take exit 135 and stay left (follow signs to Rahway). Continue around circle under the GSP and take first right to Brant Ave. Take Brant Ave to end and make a left at the light onto Westfield Ave. Continue on Westfield Ave. for 1/4 mile to the American Legion Hall on your left (large helicopter on site). Address: 78 Westfield Ave., Clark, NJ.

SKIER'S RESPONSIBILITY CODE

There are elements of risk in skiing and snowboarding that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce.

- 1. Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- **2.** People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- **3.** You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- **4.** Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- 5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- **6.** Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- **7.** Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride, and unload safely.

THE 2018 NJ SKI & SNOWBOARD COUNCIL STANLEY SHARAGA MEMORIAL PRESIDENT'S RACE

The 2018 NJSSC Stanley Sharaga Memorial President's Race was held on March 24 2018, at Hunter Mt. Ski Bowl and was again a great success, with seven clubs represented. The race had a total of 91 racers running the race. The race was held as a dual race on the new race trail, Lower Broadway. The Hunter Racing Foundation and Hunter Mt. grooming team once again provided a great course.

This year the scoring was done differently than in past years. NASTAR returned to Hunter Mt. for the first time in several years and therefore, the race results were based on age-adjusted NASTAR points (rather than a straight handicap). In other words, a 20-something year old racer will receive less NASTAR Points than a 60-something year old racer with the same race time. The program is designed to level the playing field. Results for men and women were ranked from lowest to highest NASTAR Points and divided into three equal groups. Points were awarded within each group starting at 30 on down. Team score was based on the top four men and top three women point scores. In this way clubs with the not as good racers had an equal shot at winning the race, and the more racers a club had the better chance to win.

Top team awards were: 1st – Trailsweepers, 2nd – Ramapo, and 3rd – Ski Bums. The individual scoring was again divided into thirds with awards for Class A, B, and C racers. The women's Class A winner was Carlene Bassell from Ramapo, with 2nd place going to Linda Burns from High Life and 3rd place won by Millie Bailey from Trailsweepers. The men's Class A winner was Yuri Kobziar, followed by Tyler Bailey, both from Trailsweepers, with third place going to Steve Gomez from Ramapo. The Class B men's and women's winners were Steve Fronaphel from Ski Bums and Marissa DeSouter of Ramapo, 2nd place going to Rich Herr from Trailside and Sharon Kenney from Trailsweepers, with 3rd place going to Mark Mintz from Watchung and Barbara Doxey of Ramapo. The Class C winners were Caroline Kornutik of Watchung and Greg Schneider of Ramapo. Second place went to Diana Ziegenfelder from Trailsweepers and Rich Phillips of Ski Bums, with third place going to Brittany Klim of Garden State and Marc Kornutik of Watchung.

The junior racers were originally to be divided into two age groups. Unfortunately, there was only one junior that raced. For the pre-teen boys, the winner was Nick Schneider of Ramapo. It is hoped that more juniors will participant in next year's race.

Many thanks to all the people who helped organize and run this race. The purpose of the Stanley Sharaga Memorial President's Race is to bring members of the NJSSC together in a friendly and competitive environment. The race is open to skiers of all ages and abilities, including children. Trophies and prizes are awarded at the end of the day. In addition to individual and team awards, there is a lottery style drawing for prizes, which is open to any racer who has completed at least two gates.

Next year's race will again be hosted by the NJSSC Race Committee, and is scheduled for either March 16 or March 24, 2019 at Hunter Mountain.
