THE NEW JERSEY SKI & SNOWBOARD COUNCIL

Purpose: The Council was formed in November 1939 to promote amateur skiing, assist in the development of new clubs, sponsor and run inter-club competition, and generally to promote club activities in skiing. It is incorporated as a "corporation not-for-profit" in New Jersey.

Membership: The New Jersey Ski & Snowboard Council does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national, or ethnic origin in club membership or any sponsored activity. Club membership is available to any active, organized ski, snowboard, or any other snowsports club in the State of New Jersey and adjacent areas upon application and meeting certain requirements (By-Laws, membership list, and council meeting attendance). Contact any Council Officer for information.

Meetings: Each member club elects or appoints a representative to the Council, who has one vote at general meetings. Individual club members are also encouraged to attend Council meetings. Regular meetings of the Council are held the second Monday of each month, October through May, via Zoom.

On occasion, the Council may call an in-person meeting at a location to be determined by the Executive Board of the Council. When this arises, the Council will disseminate the date, time, location, and directions to the selected venue in advance of said meeting.

The secretary of the Council will provide the Zoom link to the club presidents, representatives, and alternate representatives of each club in advance of each meeting.

SKIER'S RESPONSIBILITY CODE

There are elements of risk in skiing and snowboarding that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce.

- **1.** Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- 2. People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
- **3.** Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
- **4.** Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
- **5.** You must prevent runaway equipment.
- 6. Read and obey all signs, warnings, and hazard markings.
- 7. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- **8.** You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
- 9. Do not use lifts or terrain when imparied by alcohol or drugs.
- **10.** If you are involved in a collision or incident, share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee.

Know and Obey the Code. It's Your Responsibility.



THE 2023 NJ SKI & SNOWBOARD COUNCIL STANLEY SHARAGA MEMORIAL PRESIDENT'S RACE

The 2023 NJSSC Stanley Sharaga Memorial President's Race was held on March 18, 2023, at Hunter Mt. Ski Bowl and was again a great success, with seven clubs represented. The race had a total of 59 racers. The race was held on the new race trail, Lower Broadway. The Hunter Racing Foundation and Hunter Mt. grooming team once again provided a great course. This year the scoring was done differently than in past years. NASTAR returned again to Hunter Mt. and therefore, the race results were based on age-adjusted NASTAR points (rather than a straight handicap). In other words a 20-something year old racer will receive less NASTAR Points than a 60-something year old racer with the same race time. The program is designed to level the playing field. Results for men and women were ranked from lowest to highest NASTAR Points and divided into three equal groups. Points were awarded within each group, starting at 30 on down. Team score was based on the top four men point scores and top three women point scores. In this way, clubs with the not so good racers had an equal shot at winning the race, and the more racers a club had the better chance to win.

This proved to be true, as the first place team, Garden State, had the most racers. The second place team was Ramapo and third place went to High Life. The individual scoring was again divided into thirds with awards for Class A, B, and C racers. The women's Class A winner was Carlene Bassell from Ramapo, with 2nd place going to Kari Hoyt from Trailsweepers and 3rd place won by Karen Sanderson from Ramapo. The men's Class A winner was Dale Ziegenfelder from Trailsweepers, followed by Glenn Defrancisco of Ski Bums, with third place going to Stu Bassell from Ramapo. The Class B men's and women's winners were Tom Murante from Garden State and Kat Visich of Garden State, 2nd place going to Mitch Stachowicz from Garden State and Isabella Michaels from Ramapo, with 3rd place going to Bill Sabanski from Ski Bums and Nancy Frim from High Life. The Class C winners were Kathy Melody from Garden State and Skip Alford from Trailsweepers. second place went to Maryann Mecca from High Life and Nick Linker from Watchung with third place going to Barbara Doxey from Ramapo and Patrick Weaver of Ski Bums.

Many thanks to all the people who helped organize and run this race. The purpose of the Stanley Sharaga Memorial President's Race is to bring members of the NJSSC together in a friendly and competitive environment. The race is open to skiers of all ages and abilities, including children. Trophies, medals and prizes are awarded at the end of the day.
